WORK PROGRAMME REPORT

1.0 Purpose of Report

- 1.1. The Committee has agreed the attached work programme
- 1.2. The report gives members the opportunity to be updated on work programme items and review the shape of the work ahead.

2.0 Background

- 2.1 The scope of this Committee is defined as:

'The needs of vulnerable adults and older people and people whose independence needs to be supported by intervention from the public or voluntary sector.'

3.0 Extra Care

- 3.1 The Committee has periodically received reports on the delivery of extra care housing schemes across the County. The Directorate has recently prepared a procurement process to identify a partner or partners to develop, manage and operate up to 30 extra care housing schemes across the County by April 2020. This was considered at the Executive meeting on 9 July 2013. In addition to being kept abreast of progress on this, your Group Spokespersons have agreed that at least one visit be made to an extra care facility in the County, but that this be in April 2014 at the earliest.

4.0 Carers

- 4.1 Group Spokespersons agreed that because of the weight of business on your agenda, the programmed item on carers be deferred to the January meeting. The Chair of the Carer's Forum will be invited to comment on progress against implementation of the Carer's Strategy Plan and discuss carers' issues generally.
- 4.2 In addition, Group Spokespersons have agreed that the analysis of the operation and effectiveness of Short-Term Assessment and Re-

ablement be brought forward from the 24 April meeting as it appears currently in the work programme, to 23 January.

5.0 Autism in North Yorkshire

- 5.1 The Committee has shown an interest in the development of the Autism Strategy on previous occasions and has asked for regular updates.
- 5.2 The Strategy is now being developed and will be submitted to the Health and Wellbeing Board and Integrated Commissioning Board later this year. It should, of course, also be reviewed by this Committee. This has been agreed for 23 January, by which time it will have been approved by the Directorate's internal processes and the Portfolio Holders, the Internal Commissioning Board and the Health and Wellbeing Board. In the meantime, Group Spokespersons will be briefed at their December meeting.

6.0 Recommendations

- 6.1 The Committee is recommended to consider the attached work programme and determine whether any further amendments should be made at this stage.
