CONSIDERED –

RESOLVED –

- (i) that subject to satisfactory references, medical checks and Police/Criminal Records Bureau clearance, the post of Corporate Director for Social Services should be offered to the preferred candidate;

- (ii) that the post be offered at the salary agreed by the Sub-Committee on a standard contract of service;
- (iii) that the Chief Executive Officer, in consultation with the Deputy Leader of the County Council, should have discretion to increase the offer by no more than one increment if this proved necessary to make the appointment;
- (iv) that the consequential effects on other Chief Officer posts be noted;
- (v) in the event of the offer being turned down, the Sub-Committee should reconvene to consider making an offer to their second choice.
