No feedback had been received in relation to home to school transport and the LA were working with the Diocese in terms of property issues.

3.	BISHOP THORNTON CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL — PROPOSAL TO TRANSFER TO A NEW SITE	
	CONSIDERED: report, presented by Andrew Dixon and John Lee, providing Executive Members with information upon which to make a decision on the proposal published by the Governing Body of Bishop Thornton Church of England (Voluntary Controlled) Primary School to transfer Bishop Thornton CE Primary School to a new site at Burnt Yates from 1 September 2019.	
	John Lee reported on the Governors' proposal to move to larger premises which had been supported by the majority of parents. No representations had been received during the Statutory Notice period however. John Lee confirmed that the

governors would be responsible for the future name of the school which would need to be representative of the school's community.

Cllr Mulligan enquired as to whether this move would increase parental preference for the school and officers responded that this was an unknown however with the closure of Burnt Yates which would increase the potential take up given level of parental support for the proposal. Cllr Mulligan asked whether Governors would be issuing a press release.

Officers highlighted that there may be need to consult on catchment area changes mindful of the changes made to Ripley School's catchment area following the closure of Burnt Yates Primary School. The need for equitability was stressed.

AGREED: That the following proposal be determined:

To transfer Bishop Thornton CE Primary School to a new site at Burnt Yates near Harrogate, North Yorkshire, HG3 3EJ (the former premises of Burnt Yates Church of England Primary School) from 1 September 2019.
