2.	COUNTY MUSIC SERVICE FEES 2020/21															
	<p>CONSIDERED: report, presented by Ian Bangay, seeking approval for fees and charges for the County Music Service for the financial year 2020/21.</p> <p>The increase in teachers' pay and consequent impact on costs was noted. There was consensus that any further increase may result in drop off by service users particularly in those areas of the County where private tuition was easily available. Cllr Mulligan enquired about the take up vs whole class instrumental tuition and it was noted that there had been increased interest by primary schools recently linked to the new Ofsted inspection framework.</p> <p>Cllr Mulligan asked whether technology had been linked to a decline in take up by offering students opportunity to self teach and Ian Bangay responded that certain instruments remained extremely popular but that in recent years music had not been a high priority within secondary education due to other curriculum pressures. There was discussion about opportunity to generate income through offering services more widely or through sponsorship.</p> <p>AGREED: that termly fees and charges be agreed as follows:</p> <p>1. 	<p>CONSIDERED: report, presented by Howard Emmett, seeking approval to increase the provider base funded rate for universal and extended funded entitlement for three and four year olds and the provider funding rate for disadvantaged two year olds for the 2020/21 financial year.</p> <p>AGREED:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To increase the provider base funded rate for the universal and extended funded entitlement for three and four year olds from £4.01 per hour to £4.09 per hour for the 2020/21 financial year. 2. To increase the provider funding rate for disadvantaged two year olds from £5.20 to £5.28 per hour for the 2020/21 financial year. 3. ACTION: Martin Kelly to pick up. • Cllr Sanderson relayed her and Cllr Wilkinson's request for confirmation that Youth Executive (NYP) arrangements were clear on what to do in the event of a safeguarding disclosure as part of young people's' discussions. <p>Youth Justice Inspection – Stuart confirmed that preparations were in place. The YJS Management Board was to be held on 11 March as planned.</p>
