Addendum - Results from Consultation

- 1. The results of the consultation with affected domiciliary care and community based providers was not available to include in the main report published on 20th April.
- 2. This addendum therefore sets out the results and should be read in conjunction with the main report.
- Affected domiciliary care and community based care providers within the County were contacted and invited to take part in a survey regarding the proposed fee levels and future inflationary uplifts. The survey was conducted through Survey Monkey between 19 February and 20 March 2018 (4 weeks).
- 4. The responses are summarised below:

- 5. There were no additional comments from providers and providers made no suggestions for any changes to the Draft Equality Impact Assessments, which are attached to the main report.
- 6. No separate representation has been made to the proposals by the Independent Care Group.
- No consultation was undertaken with Residential and Nursing Care homes, because the approach to inflationary uplifts was agreed in 2016 for a period of at least four years.
- 8. Officers have considered the responses to the consultation. The combination of a low response level and the agreement of all who did respond lead Officers to recommend the proposals as they stand. Where there is opposition to proposals the response rate is usually higher. No alterations are proposed to the Equality Impact Assessments
