

The Report of the Allocations Committee

There are 68 Electoral Divisions, 64 of which each return one Member and four of which each return two Members.

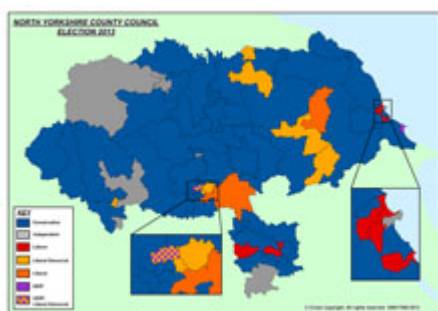
