

11/06 - **2005/06 CORPORATE ACTION PLAN YEAR END PERFORMANCE:** The Performance Manager submitted a written report, the purpose of which was to outline the Council's 2005/06 Performance on the 70 actions contained in the Corporate Action Plan. The information would be used in the 2006/07 Performance Plan to be published at the end of June 2006. The Performance Manager advised that next year the three reports received by Members at this evening's meeting would be brought together into a single document and that the Corporate Action Plan would now be superseded by the Strategic Plan and Performance Plan. The Chair invited Members' questions in relation to the report. The Executive Director, Corporate Policy and Improvement, advised that the report represented good performance on the part of the Council generally and that this was thought to be significant in a year of change following the Corporate restructuring.

Councillor Broadbank queried item 6.2.2, in relation to the 'Articulation of the Council's vision, priorities and allocation of resources into a single annual report', and the Executive Director Corporate Policy and Improvement advised that whilst it was disappointing that this action had not been realised, the very same information would be contained in the June Performance Report and that the Council Annual Report would now be published and be available to the public for the first time in 2007. It was then unanimously **agreed** that the report be received and the information contained therein endorsed.
