<p>2. <b>Key Decision:</b> (Title of item and description of the matter and why it is considered a key decision)</p> <p>The Council, acting through the Chief Executive and Chief Solicitor, makes a request to the Secretary of State in accordance with section 5 of the Localism Act 2011 to remove the restrictions imposed by the Stray Act 1985 for a defined geographical area of the Stray and for a limited period to enable the Tour de France event to proceed.</p> <p>It is a key decision because of the scale of the Tour de France event and the areas of the Stray which may be affected are within the boundaries of at least 2 wards. This is therefore an executive decision which is likely to be significant in terms of its effect on communities living or working within 2 or more wards.</p>
