

55/05 – 2004/2005 PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

A. Year-end report: The Performance Officer submitted a written report to outline the Council's performance during 2004/05 on all of its Performance Indicators (PI's), the Council's performance on national and local Performance Indicators and those included within the Council's Corporate Basket of Performance Indicators. In advising of a number of minor corrections to the report the Performance Officer referred Cabinet to the executive summary with regard to the Council's performance as outlined Section 5 of the report.

In line with the key role given to the Council's Overview and Scrutiny Commissions in connection with performance management arrangements this report was considered in tandem with that of the Chair of the Environment Overview and Scrutiny Commission's report below, the views of the Community Services and Resources Overview and Scrutiny Commissions being reported to Cabinet at its next meeting on 19 September 2005.

In the context of both this report and that of the Chair of the Environment Overview and Scrutiny Commission the Executive Director, Corporate Policy and Improvement, advised of the review of performance management that would shortly be commenced and would aim to address a number of existing anomalies and presentational issues in respect of certain indicators.
