33/06 – **Proposed Compulsory Purchase of a Long-Term Empty Property – Lands Lane, Knaresborough:** In response to a question from Councillor Pat Marsh with regard to any surplus funds received as a result of any compulsory acquisition of the premises and its subsequent sale being ring-fenced for affordable housing elsewhere in the district, the Leader agreed to let the Member have a written reply.

It was moved by Councillor Houlton and seconded by Councillor Pat Marsh:

That Minute 33/06 be referred back to Cabinet for reconsideration.

The reference back was subsequently withdrawn.

34/06 – **Medium Term Financial Strategy 2007/08 to 2009/10.** In response to a question from Councillor Broadbank regarding the level of inflation at District Council level, the Leader advised that there were many factors which had to be taken into account at arriving at such a figure and which for the purposes of this exercise had been determined as 3.9%.

In response to a question from Councillor Reg Marsh regarding other non-demand lead expenditure budgets, the Cabinet Member for Finance and Resources, Councillor Andrew Jones agreed to let the Member have appropriate examples.

The Minutes of the meeting of the Cabinet held on 26 July 2006 were then unanimously approved and adopted.
