Fire

These ground rules are about Team North Yorkshire Health and Wellbeing Board and should apply within and outside of Board meetings. They were adopted by Board members in June 2015.

We have made a commitment that when working together we will treat each other with respect, with openness and honesty. We will make sure that there is equality – everyone is of equal value in the room. We will contribute and take part, committing to listen and ask questions of each other, checking that what we heard is what was intended. We shouldn't expect the same sort of challenge in the public arena.

Our discussions need to focus on added value and outcomes and we must take responsibility for our decisions. We should ensure that we communicate and cascade to our respective audiences and organisations.
