Subject: 09/02345,6 &7/FUL; Extensions, etc to form a poultry shed, Mill Farm, Brandsby

I visited the site of 11th September and have the following comments to make:

~ The roof sheets on the new sections of building should match the colour of the roof sheets on the existing building, i.e. dark grey. Marley Eternit Farmscape sheeting in Anthracite would be a suitable dark grey matt colour (other similar products may be available). It is important that the colour of the new sheeting matches this dark grey - the sheets on the existing shed would have been a much lighter colour when they were new and the colour we see now is their weathered state. It is important to Condition dark grey sheeting from the outset with the roof extension areas, as light grey sheeting takes many years to reach this more acceptable dark grey shade.

~ The feed silos should have a matt, dark-coloured finish if possible.

~ Although landscaping is in place around the main poultry sheds area, this does not screen the proposed new shed development. A landscaping scheme of appropriate native trees and shrubs should therefore be installed along the north-western boundary of the site, between the road and the existing landscaping.
