#### **INTERESTS**

The Local Access Forums (England) Regulations 2002 state:-

(7) A member of a Local Access Forum who is directly or indirectly interested in any matter brought up for consideration at a meeting of the Forum shall disclose the nature of his interest to the meeting

(Those members of the Local Access Forum who are County Councillors are also bound by the North Yorkshire County Council Members' Code of Conduct, as they serve on the Forum as County Councillors. County Councillors must, therefore, declare any personal interest they may have in any matter considered at a meeting and, if that interest is prejudicial, must so declare it and leave the meeting during consideration of that item.)

### **EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR MEETINGS**

#### **FIRE**

The fire evacuation alarm is a continuous Klaxon. On hearing this you should leave the building by the nearest safe fire exit. From Meeting Room 2 this is either the main entrance stairway or the staircase outside Meeting Room 3. Once outside the building please proceed to the fire assembly point outside the main entrance

Persons should not re-enter the building until authorised to do so by the Fire and Rescue Service or the Emergency Co-ordinator.

An intermittent alarm indicates an emergency in nearby building. It is not necessary to evacuate the building but you should be ready for instructions from the Fire Warden.

If you discover a fire, you should sound the alarm and then dial 9-999 asking the Fire Brigade to come to the main County Hall Building, Northallerton. You should then dial 0 and inform the switchboard as to where the fire is.

There are alarm points at each end of the Meeting Room corridor – and at the main stairway.
