- 2.10 Grimston Moor
- Walk down tarmac lane to track into wood – Forestry Commission land, gate access issue at eastern end, interpretation
- 2.20 Yearsley Moor
- Walk down access track, as far as Windy Gates cottage?
- Forestry Commission leasehold land.
