1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To provide details of the work undertaken by the Ranger Teams for the current financial year.

2.0 FIGURES

1.1 The Maintenance team is targeted to resolve 3200 issues on the network per year and the contribution of each Ranger Team is monitored over the year. The following table shows issues resolved and current outstanding issues (as at 6 May 2009)

- 2.2 The target for 2008/09 was met, there was a close correlation between the highest number of outstanding issues and the highest number of resolved issues, showing that resource is being directed to the correct areas.
- 2.3 Additional resource was directed at signposting and bridges in the last quarter of the year, although the resolved bridge issues have yet to filter onto the system as work is still being quality assessed by the bridges section.
- 2.4 The total outstanding issues figure has increased by 306 issues since November's report to the LAF. This figure includes an adjustment for 'In Hand' work which is now counted in the unresolved figure.

3.0 IMPACT ON THE NETWORK

- 2.1 The work of the Ranger Teams translates into significant improvements for users on the ground. A slideshow will follow demonstrating some of the practical improvements that have been made over the last year

4.0 CONCLUSION
