1. <u>APPOINTMENT OF CHAIR</u>

3. LGNYY CONSTITUTION AND RULES - ADOPTION

CONSIDERED -

Final draft of LGNYY's Constitution.

During debate, the role of the National Park Authorities was raised. Members expressed the view that democratic accountability rested with the nine Councils, although they were very committed to engaging and involving both National Parks. It was suggested that the following should be included in the Constitution and Rules:-"13.3 A representative of each National Park may attend but not vote at a meeting of LGNYY when planning issues affecting the National Parks are discussed".

The Honorary Secretary highlighted that he did not envisage that confidential or exempt information would be submitted LGNYY meetings. However, if such a situation arose, he would identify the confidential/exempt information, restrict circulation, and ensure everyone was made aware of the limitations.

RESOLVED -

That the Constitution and Rules, as set out at pages 1 to 6 of the papers for this meeting, be formally adopted, subject to the addition of the following:- "13.3 A representative of each National Park may attend but not vote at a meeting of LGNYY when planning issues affecting the National Parks are discussed".

5. LGNYY THEMATIC BOARDS – MEMBERSHIP AND WORKING ARRANGEMENTS

CONSIDERED -

Report of the Honorary Secretary inviting LGNYY to consider the membership and working arrangements of its Thematic Boards. A detailed paper from Jonathan French (York and North Yorkshire Partnership Unit) was appended to the report which set out suggestions for a LGNYY Economy and Skills Board.

During debate, it was noted that the National Parks had officer representation on the proposed LGNYY Economy and Skills Board.

RESOLVED -

- (a) That an Economy and Skills Board, as set out in the Appendix to the report, be established.
- (b) That a Transport Board, with the following working arrangements, be established:-
 - to comprise one Member from each of the nine Councils, together with one Member from each National Park who shall have voting rights;
 - to be chaired in alternating years by the County Council and the City of York Council;
 - the Board to determine how to use existing structures to ensure the level of coordination that is required for a voice for the sub-region;
 - the Board to be supported by the County Council;
 - the current informal arrangements for officers to work together to be formalised.
- (c) That, subject to appropriate amendments to its Constitution, the existing North Yorkshire Strategic Housing Board be re-established as a Housing and Regeneration Board, to include the following working arrangements:-
 - to include one Member from each National Park who shall have voting rights;
 - the Board to be supported by the current secretariat to the North Yorkshire Strategic Housing Board, ie Harrogate Borough Council.
- (d) That a Planning Board, with the following working arrangements, be established:-
 - to comprise one Member from each of the nine Councils, together with one Member from each National Park who shall have voting rights;
 - the current officer arrangements to be formalised into a group that can properly support the Member led group and liaise with officers at regional level;
 - the Board to be supported by the City of York Council.

6. <u>REPORTING ARRANGEMENTS FOR LGNYY THEMATIC BOARDS AND FOR</u> <u>REPRESENTATIVES ON OUTSIDE BODIES</u>

CONSIDERED -

Verbal report of the Honorary Secretary recommending that a Member or officer from each LGNYY Thematic Board and from each outside body to which LGNYY appoints should be expected to provide a brief feedback note to each meeting of LGNYY.

RESOLVED –

That LGNYY expects a Member or officer from each LGNYY Thematic Board and outside body to provide a brief feedback note for each meeting of LGNYY.

It was noted that the involvement of the National Parks in LGNYY had been included during consideration of earlier items of business at this meeting.

Verbal report of Councillor Arthur Barker (Hambleton District Council) concerning discussions of the Leaders' Board relating mainly to timetables, strategy and the need to respond to the current economic situation.

Verbal report of Carole Hassan (Chief Executive, LGNY), accompanied by Chris Taylor (Director, RIEP), concerning the way in which the work of the former Regional Assembly had been integrated into LGYH and also advising of the priorities of LGYH and RIEP.

10. FLOODING

CONSIDERED -

Verbal report of Mike Roberts (Head of Highway Operations, North Yorkshire County Council) providing a brief update, as a pre-curser to a more substantive discussion at a future meeting, concerning the national situation following publication of the final report "The Pitt Review: Lessons learned from the 2007 floods". A briefing note was circulated summarising Councils' roles as set out in the Flood and Water Management Bill and referring to the likely shift in Environment Agency priorities. It was noted that the national view within local government was that the Bill would not

work unless there was sufficient funding and expertise within local authorities. Carole Hassan advised that LGYH was undertaking work to establish costs.
