3. Growing Places Update

TF presented an update to the Board on progress to date with the Growing Places fund along with plans for future investment.

The fund will move to a more proactive approach to investing the fund, seeking to bring forward strategic opportunities & commission activity.

Three of the projects that made presentations to the panel of Board Members on 1st June have been through final diligence on the business cases. Two of the projects have been turned down as a result, with one going forward. The three remaining projects will go through business case diligence shortly. It was agreed that the LEP should invest the funds wisely and not spend for spending sake.

5. Strategic Review

JF presented the Board with the LEP Strategic Review, showing the framework for a discussion to agree the direction, strategic objectives and priorities for the LEP for 2012/13 and beyond.

It was agreed that the vision should be "Grow our Business Faster"

Our priority activities must be focused on delivering this vision.

A wide range of potential opportunities were discussed including;

- Support for small businesses delivering the offers we have developed with the private sector
- Networks Important as our route to market and positive feedback from the recent event. There is an opportunity to develop this further, improving the cross network activity. SW to take board lead.
- Skills we should focus on skills which deliver growth.
- Visitor Economy must not compete with existing organisations, e.g W2Y. Focus should be on innovation and business improvement. There could be a potential pilot in Bridlington working with East Riding. PO & SP to take Board lead.
- Ageing Population PO suggested investing money in setting up a retirement village. Pros and cons with this. Set up task and Finish Group to discuss further.
- Potash & Renewables Need to focus where we add value building of Scarborough BC existing activity i.e supply chain opportunities, skills development. RM to take Board Lead.
- Agri-Innovation BD has been involved in a recent Technology Strategy Board visit to FERA and David Willets MP is visiting on 20th. BD involved.

This has the potential to be a major strategic development in the region. BD & DK to take Board lead.

- Strategic Infrastructure Sites LEP to support LA's where appropriate to realise potential developments. For example
 - o York Central
 - Whitby Business Park
- Lobbying LEP has a key role to be a champion for local business and must be seen to be active. We need a plan to increase our profile in local areas.
