1. The purpose of this report is to provide a framework for Members to be updated on how both initiatives are being implemented.

**Introduction**

2. In January 2009 the Department of Health issued national guidance, "*Transforming Community Services: Enabling new patterns of service provision*" under which Primary Care Trusts (PCTs) were required to have determined the future organisational model for separating their provider and commissioning functions by October 2010.
3. Members will recall that the Committee has been briefed throughout the change process. This report is an opportunity for the Committee to be updated on how the changes are being implemented.
4. A letter from Sue Metcalfe, Deputy Chief Executive - Director of Localities, NHS NY&Y, on this matter is attached as Appendix 1.
5. Sue Metcalfe and Melanie Bradbury, Assistant Director, NHS NY&Y, will be attending the meeting to brief Members personally and to respond to questions.

**RE: Transforming Community Services - and Mental Health, Learning Disabilities and Substance Misuse procurement**

Further to my letter of 26 January 2011, I am writing to update you on progress in respect of the above.

**Community services transfer to new providers**

Following an extensive consultation process which started on 1 November 2010, thousands of staff working in our community services have now received letters confirming their transfer to their new organisations as part of the Transforming Community Services project. These new organisations are as follows:

- Airedale NHS Foundation Trust
- Harrogate and District NHS Foundation Trust
- South Tees Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust
- York Teaching Hospital NHS Foundation Trust

The transfer will come into effect from 1 April 2011 under the Transfer of Employment (Protection of Employment) Regulations 2006.

Attached with this letter is a breakdown of which services will be managed by which organisation from 1 April. I hope this will help to clarify the new arrangements.

**Mental Health, Learning Disabilities and Substance Misuse – timetable for transfer**

The Board of NHS North Yorkshire and York agreed in 2010 that the mental health, learning disabilities services and substance misuse services that it hosted would be formally tendered. These services were apportioned into three lots which reflected the most natural flow of patients into services, and to ensure a wide competitive field was captured for the procurement.



**Lot 1** consists of York, Selby and Tadcaster, and also includes North Yorkshire and York-wide Specialist Eating Disorder Services and Improving Access to Psychological Therapies (IAPT). In January, the PCT's Board approved a three-year contract for Leeds Partnerships NHS Foundation Trust to manage these services.

The proposed date of transfer of services to Leeds Partnership NHS Foundation Trust has been agreed as 1 October 2011.

**Lot 2** consists of the Harrogate district (with outreach to Craven where appropriate) and **Lot 3** consists of the Hambleton and Richmondshire districts (with outreach to Scarborough, Whitby and Ryedale). The PCT's Board approved a three-year contract for Tees Esk and Wear Valleys NHS Foundation Trust to manage these services.

The proposed date of transfer for those mental health services transferring to Tees, Esk and Wear Valleys NHS Foundation Trust has been agreed as 1 June 2011.
