continue, led by Ms Christine Bleasby. Without the purchase the group would have ceased to operate due to the unmanageable (for
her) weight of the previous sound amplification equipment. Happily, the singing group has continued through 2017 and we fervently
hope that it will throughout 2018.

Singing as part of a group has a recognised beneficial effect on feelings of wellbeing in elderly people.
