Eastern Area Forum Minutes of the Meeting

Open Session

The open session had consultation tables from organisations including: Councillors, staff from North Yorkshire Highways, Police, Fire & Rescue Service, Selby District Council Community Officers, British Gas and Bee Able

Cllr Liz Casling welcomed everyone to the meeting.

NY Police Update - Adam Wood Selby Rural SNT

Crime is down compared to this time last year.

For the Eastern CEF area there were 3 reported burglaries early in the month, one business and one shed broken into.

Reports from residents of Barlby saying about ASB in the village (from the last meeting/ parish council meetings etc.), this has been looked at and will continue to monitor when possible. Youths have been spoken with and any offences dealt with. Following this positive action, this month, there has been 4 reported incidents in the month showing a reduction in the calls for service to the area for this type of incident.

There has been a few arson and poaching incidents over the District as a whole, although NYP are patrolling and looking into incidents/ offences/ vulnerable areas etc, we ask that anyone witnessing suspect activity reports it via the 101 system.

All Saints Church, Bolton Percy, Planning Committee

Tricia and Denise talked through the development of their project to repair the damaged church roof, tower and belfry and at the same time develop the community activities taking place in the village.

For the past 2 years they have worked with Selby District AVS achieving the following;

- Community consultation with all residents in the village to gather ideas and opinions
- Creation of a Community Committee to develop a Heritage Lottery application
- Running a series of community events that has created a further 30 volunteers in the village
- The successful initial bid of £22,300 to develop plans to restore the building.
