1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To review the Standards Committee's Standards Training Plan for 2011/12.

2.0 BACKGROUND

2.1 The Standards Committee has agreed a Training Plan for the Authority regarding the ethical framework and periodically monitors training planned and undertaken.

3.0 TRAINING ISSUES

- 3.1 An updated Training Plan is attached at Appendix 1 for Members' information. Historical information about training received over the last few years has been removed from the Plan, with the exception of that received in 2010 or dates of the last training received, which have been retained.
- 3.2 Given the Government's intention to "abolish the Standards Board regime", as proposed in the Localism Bill, it is recommended that due to the uncertainty of the situation, no further standards training for Members is planned until the proposals for any new standards regime for the Authority are clearer. The Plan has been amended on that basis.
- 3.3 Members are requested to consider the Training Plan and determine whether any amendments are required at this time.
- 3.4 Members will be kept informed of progress in relation to standards training issues.
