INTEGRATED SERVICES IN LOCALITIES

Purpose of Report

1. This purpose of this report is to provide the Committee with background information and a progress report on Integrated Services within localities.

Background

2. The Children and Young Peoples Plan sets out strategies to promote the five statutory outcomes for children and young people, namely that they should: Be healthy; Stay safe; Enjoy and achieve; Achieve economic well-being; Make a positive contribution to society.

One of the aspects of work to which the council and its partners are committed to developing is more integrated working at a local level in order to bring services closer together.

Integrated Services in localities responds to the needs of families and children and looks at how services can be delivered in ways which are more convenient for families, and ensures faster, more targeted and appropriate interventions for children who may have particular needs.
