(c) Emergency Procedures For Meetings

Fire- The fire evacuation alarm is a continuous Klaxon. On hearing this you should leave the building by the nearest safe fire exit. Once outside the building please proceed to the fire assembly point outside the main entrance

An intermittent alarm indicates an emergency in nearby building. It is not necessary to evacuate the building but you should be ready for instructions from the Fire Warden.

If you discover a fire, you should sound the alarm and then dial 9-999 asking the Fire Brigade to come to the main County Hall Building, Northallerton. You should then dial EXT 5586 and inform Reception as to where the fire is.

There are alarm points at each end of the Meeting Room corridor – and at the main stairway.

Accident or Illness First Aid treatment can be obtained by telephoning County Hall Reception on Extension 5586.
