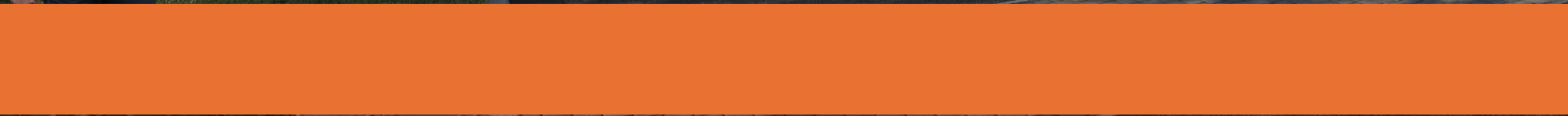

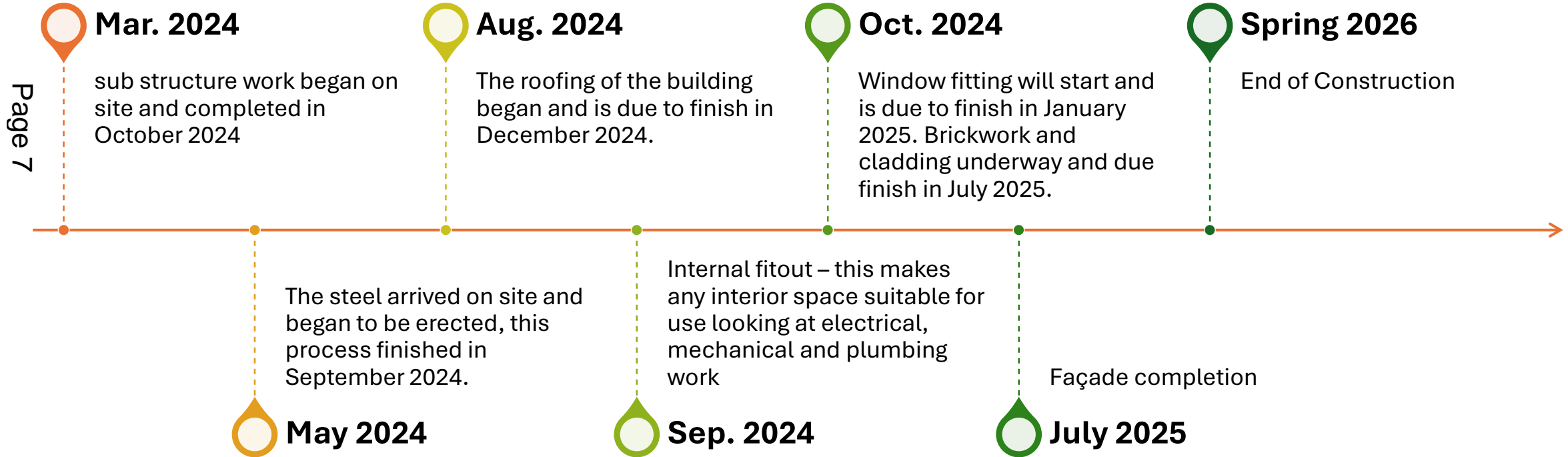

- System review underway to ensure bed-based services for complex needs continue.
- Collaborative planning with South Tees Hospital NHS Foundation Trust to design appropriate care solutions.
- Public engagement central to future decision-making and service development.
