General Licensing and Registration Sub-Committee

Procedure

Introduction

1. The Sub-Committee will conduct its hearings fairly, observing the basic rules of natural justice.
2. Each hearing will take the form of a discussion led by the Chair and cross examination will not be permitted unless the Sub-Committee considers that cross examination is necessary.
3. Hearings will be held in public but the Sub-Committee may decide to exclude the public from all or part of a hearing where it considers the public interest in doing so outweighs the public interest in the hearing taking place in public. In this context "public" includes any party to the hearing or any representative of a party.

Procedure

4. At the beginning of the meeting the Chair shall:-
 - a) ask those present to introduce themselves;
 - b) explain the procedure;
 - c) ask the parties whether they wish permission for another person to appear at the hearing.
5. The Sub-Committee will consider requests from the parties for permission for other persons to appear at the meeting. Such permission will not be unreasonably withheld.
6. The Chair will conduct the hearing taking representations from the parties in the following order:
 - a) the Licensing Officer who will outline the background to the case. The Licensing Officer's role is to provide factual information to the Sub-Committee.
 - b) the applicant/licence holder (including any person appointed to represent the party or any other persons who have been given permission to assist the party).
 - c) any party making representations (including any person appointed to represent the party or any persons who have been given permission to assist the party).

7. Before determination, the applicant/licence holder will be given the final opportunity to address the Sub-Committee.
8. Each party will be given an equal maximum period of time in which to put forward any additional information requested by the Council, to question other persons (if given permission by the Sub-Committee) and address the Sub-Committee.
9. The Sub-Committee may exclude disruptive persons in certain circumstances.
10. The Sub-Committee may adjourn the hearing in certain circumstances.
11. The Sub-Committee will ask the parties to withdraw so that it can consider its determination. In considering its determination, the Sub-Committee may ask its Legal Advisor to provide it with legal and procedural advice. The nature of this advice will be notified to the parties.
12. The Sub-Committee will make its determination at the end of the meeting and this will be confirmed in writing.

Failure of Parties to Attend a Hearing

13. If a party has informed the Council that they do not intend to attend or be represented at a hearing, the hearing may proceed in their absence.
14. Where a party has not so indicated fails to attend or be represented at a hearing the Sub-Committee may:
 - a) where it considers it to be necessary in the public interest, adjourn the hearing to a specified date; or
 - b) hold the hearing in the party's absence.
15. Where the hearing is held in the absence of a party, the authority shall consider at the hearing of the application, representation or notice made by that party.
16. Where a hearing is adjourned to a specified date the Council will notify the parties of the date, time and place to which the hearing has been adjourned.

Application for the renewal of a hackney carriage vehicle licence – HC025F

Report of the Corporate Director – Environment

1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To consider an application for a hackney carriage vehicle licence that does not comply with the standard criteria as stated in the Council’s Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Policy (“the Policy”). Such vehicles may be licensed at the discretion of the General Licensing and Registration Sub Committee.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 An application to renew a hackney carriage vehicle licence has been received from the proprietor, David Michael Harrison. The application form together with a statement in support of the application is attached at **Appendix A**.
- 2.2 As the vehicle is over ten years of age it does not comply with the vehicle age criteria outlined within the Policy which requires vehicles to be less than ten years old from the date of first registration. The vehicle was first licensed as a hackney carriage vehicle on 6 September 2016, and the current licence expired 31 October 2024.
- 2.3 Details of the vehicle are as follows:

- 2.4 As part of the renewal process, the vehicle must successfully pass the Council’s vehicle inspection. Officers can confirm that the vehicle passed its test on 4 October 2024.
- 2.5 Regarding the MOT history, the vehicle passed its most recent test on 18 September 2024, there were no advisories for this test. For the previous MOT the vehicle passed that MOT on 27 September 2023 (with two advisories). The testing history is attached at **Appendix B**.
- 2.6 Members are encouraged to view the vehicle prior to making their decision.

3.0 ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED

- 3.1 All of the Sub-Committee’s options are outlined in paragraph 10.0. No alternative options are available.

4.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

4.1 No financial implications have been identified.

5.0 LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

5.1 The Licensing Authority must determine an application for the grant of a hackney carriage vehicle licence in accordance with relevant legislation and the Council's Policy. The Licensing Authority would leave itself open to appeal at the Magistrate's Court or judicial review should it not comply with all legal requirements.

6.0 EQUALITIES IMPLICATIONS

6.1 No equalities implications have been identified.

7.0 CLIMATE CHANGE IMPLICATIONS

7.1 No climate change implications have been identified.

8.0 POLICY IMPLICATIONS

8.1 In carrying out its licensing functions, the General Licensing and Registration Sub-Committee should have regard to the Council's Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Licensing Policy.

8.2 Paragraph 8 of the Policy sets out the licensing authority's objectives which are:

- to encourage the provision of high quality and accessible hackney carriage and private hire services;
- to ensure the safety and comfort of users of hackney carriage and private hire services;
- to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the public affected by the operation of hackney carriage and private hire services; and
- to facilitate access to an efficient and effective public transport service.

8.3 Paragraph 15 of the Policy confirms the policy will be applied in the majority of cases when considering licence applications, but the licensing authority will consider each application on its individual merits and may, at times, allow exceptions to the general policy.

8.4 Paragraph 16 of the Policy confirms it will be necessary to consider, in relation to any particular application, whether the specific circumstances justify allowing an exception.

8.5 Paragraph 17 of the Policy confirms it will be up to the applicant to show that an exception should be made to the policy, and if the objectives can still be met, the licensing authority may exercise its discretion to depart from the general policy. Where exceptions are made, reasons will be given.

8.6 Paragraph 47 of the Policy outlines the hackney carriage vehicle specification which requires vehicles to be less than 10 years old (the age of the vehicle shall be taken from the date of first registration shown on the vehicle registration document, V5C). It goes on to state that the policy with regards to vehicle specification shall be applied in the majority of cases when considering licensing applications, but the licensing authority will consider each application on its individual merits and may, at times, allow exceptions to this policy. Where exceptions are made in this regard, vehicles shall be subject to three mechanical inspections each year.

9.0 REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS

9.1 The vehicle does not comply with the standard criteria as stated in the Policy; therefore, the determination of the application rests with the Sub-Committee.

10.0 RECOMMENDATION(S)

- i) to grant the application.
- ii) to grant the application including additional conditions; or
- iii) to reject the application.

Further to the below correspondence from the Taxi Permit inbox on behalf of TPE. I am now writing to you to see if you would like to extend your permit from the 06/01/2025 – 31/05/2025.

If you already have a WAV vehicle, please accept my apologies, and ignore this email.

TPE message :

"Thank you for your patience on the matter, whilst we discussed the points raised with TransPennine Express representatives.

TransPennine Express are now aware of the challenges that you and a handful of other taxi permit drivers are facing; since their most recent communication, outlining their expectation for Wheelchair Accessible Vehicles (WAV) from 1st June 2025.

It has never been the intention of TransPennine Express to prevent any taxi driver from operating at their stations and they are extremely grateful and supportive of the work they do to support the onward travel of railway customers at stations. TransPennine Express recognise the financial investment involved in upgrading vehicles to WAV

solutions and understand drivers may already hold financial commitments on their existing vehicles and would not wish for anyone to be financially out of pocket because of the upcoming WAV requirements. Despite this being a Nationwide requirement, we appreciate the efforts associated with such investment and therefore wish to outline our position as follows:

All existing permit holders will be permitted an extension to continue to operate non-WAV vehicles up until the **31st May 2025**, after which, they will be required to own a Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle before renewing any existing permits. This will allow TransPennine Express to comply with ORR regulations and allows existing permit holders additional time to invest in WAV solutions.

TransPennine would like to take the time to thank you for your feedback and for sharing the challenges you and other permit holders are currently facing. They are also keen for you to continue with any dialogue that you and other permit holders feel would improve the overall efficiency and service levels provided by both permit holders and the permit holder process"

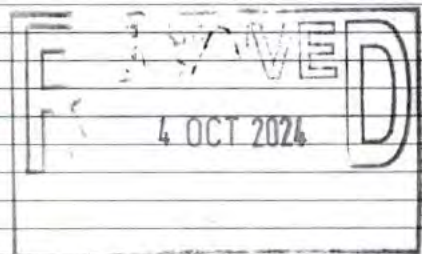

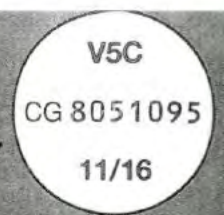
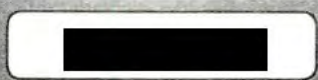
