5 Application for grant of a Premises Licence - The Treasury, 4 Baxtergate, Whitby, North Yorkshire

A report seeking consideration of an application for the grant of a premises licence in respect of The Treasury, 4 Baxtergate, Whitby, North Yorkshire. The premises were described as a bar, restaurant and café. The licensable activities and permitted hours requested in the application are as follows:

Official sale of alcohol (both on and off sales) Sunday to Thursday - 08:00 to 23:00 Friday & Saturday – 08:00 to 03:00.

Live music (both indoors & Outdoors) Sunday to Thursday - 10:00 to 23:00 Friday &

Saturday – 10:00 to 03:00.

Recorded music (both indoors & Outdoors) Sunday to Thursday - 08:00 to 23:00 Friday & Saturday – 08:00 to 03:00.

Opening Hours Sunday to Thursday - 08:00 to 23:00 Friday & Saturday – 08:00 to 03:00.

Following consultation with North Yorkshire Police and the Environmental Health department, the applicant had agreed to reduce the proposed hours for the following licensable activities:

Sale of alcohol (both on and off sales) Sunday to Thursday – 08:00 -22:30 Friday & Saturday – 08:00 - 02:30.

Live music (indoors only) Sunday to Thursday - 10:00 to 23:00 Friday & Saturday – 10:00 to 23:30.

Recorded music (indoors only) Sunday to Thursday - 08:00 to 23:00 Friday & Saturday – 08:00 to 23:30.

Representations from all parties were considered alongside the report and cross questioning was undertaken. The Sub-Committee considered all written and oral representations from all parties and taking into account all of the details provided.
