In addition to the report the Sub-Committee had sight of the Application, Premises Licence, evidence presented by NYC Environmental Health Service – Email correspondence, Noise Nuisance Investigation Report, Statement of Witness, copy Noise Abatement Notices, Extracts from the Noise App Case Report and submissions from the Applicant.
