All public Committee meetings of the Council where the public can attend have been suspended. Following on from the Prime Minister's announcement on 23 March 2020 about fundamental restrictions on public travel and movement, the Leader of the Council, ClIr Carl Les, has stopped all public, committee meetings of the Council for the foreseeable future. The council business will continue but in a different way. Emergency powers have been invoked that enable the Chief Executive, Richard Flinton, to make decisions that would previously have been made by the Council's committees. We will keep the position under review as the Government consider drafting legislation and regulations to allow for virtual meetings and we will consider how best to engage with the public to ensure that good governance, transparency and public engagement is maintained during this time.
