There is a duty for the local authority, the police, the probation service, and health named partners to cooperate in order to secure youth justice services appropriate to their area. YOTs are partially funded by the Government's youth justice grant, in addition to funding from the council and statutory partners, to deliver elements of the youth justice system at a local level. The local Youth justice plan must be submitted to the Youth Justice Board by 30 June 2023 to ensure timely payment of our Youth Justice Grant 2023/24. We are awaiting confirmation of the							

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					actual amount of grant funding however the Youth Justice board have advised in a letter dated 17th March that they hope to be able to confirm your 2023/24 grant funding in Spring 2023. We have been advised that the funding for 2023/2024 will be similar to that of the previous year.
