- ⑥ There were 7 providers offering specific provision for SEND offering 1,226 SEND places:
 - Harrogate – 3 providers – 190 FSM places
 - Craven - 1 providers - 160 FSM places
 - Scarborough - 3 providers - 876 FSM places

Summer 2022

- ⑥ 35 providers – Specialising in Sport
- ⑥ 28 providers – Specialising in Art
- ⑥ There are 12 providers offering provision for SEND offering 6,868 SEND places:
 - Harrogate – 7 providers – 2676 FSM places
 - Craven - 2 providers - 2520 FSM places
 - Scarborough - 3 providers - 1672 FSM places

Age group challenges

Primary Age (6 – 11)

- ⑥ Social stigma of accessing the programme

Secondary Age (11 – 16)

- ⑥ Suitable activities being provided
- ⑥ Engaging young people to participate
- ⑥ Sparsity of providers (4 Districts have no provision for over 11's)
- ⑥ Rurality and ability to move around during holidays

The future for NYT and FEAST

- ⑥ 2.5 year contract for FEAST
- ⑥ Continued support for Afghan Refugees to September
- ⑥ Looking at other opportunities to provide support to young people
- ⑥ Local Government Review
