Last year while operating under Tens licences for weddings and private parties neighbours along the access road Green Hills Lane needed to call the police on several occasions. This occurred while attendees were walking along the lane in a drunk state—shouting and screaming as they went by. The Residents felt vulnerable and unable to ask them to stop in case they were abused. This eventually led to the Environmental Health Issuing a Noise Abatement order which is still in place. I would suggest the licence is restricted to the hours of the wedding receptions which would be from 12 middday until 11pm on Saturdays only. This would avoid it happening at any other time of the week If this is something you felt you cant do could I suggest—you refuse this application and ask the applicant apply for Tens licence instead for each event so that more control could be in place should the problems continue.

They do not as yet have planning permission to hold weddings etc

These problems arose while holding a small number of weddings during the summer of 2022 I see the applicant has applied to to play live music indoor and out from 8.00 am until 00.00 and recorded music indoor for a similar time for 7 days a week. Although he may not use the times quoted he would still have the ability to do so so that the problems we had last year would be multiplied many times.

I know when I contacted your office you said that could be controlled by conditions imposed by environmental health but is it not also a fact that if you controlled both time and days it would act as a great deterrent to the applicant to control both the public nuisance and crime and disorder.

The loss of a premises licence would be far more effective if he exceeded the specified timings
