6 MONTH RULE

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 A decision is needed to grant a dispensation from the 6 month rule for any Members who cannot attend meetings owing to Covid-19.

2.0 RECOMMENDATION(S)

- 2.1 It is recommended that:
 - (i) A dispensation is approved from the 6 month rule for any Members who cannot attend meetings owing to Covid-19.
 - (ii) The Leader and Chair of Council is consulted.

3.0 REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION(S)

3.1 To ensure no Members are deemed to have resigned because they have not attended meetings owing to illness or self-isolation.

delegated to the Monitoring Officer to give dispensation as required, after considering		
circumstances on a case by case basis, but this power should last only until the next		
meeting of Full Council, after which council can give dispensation as required.
