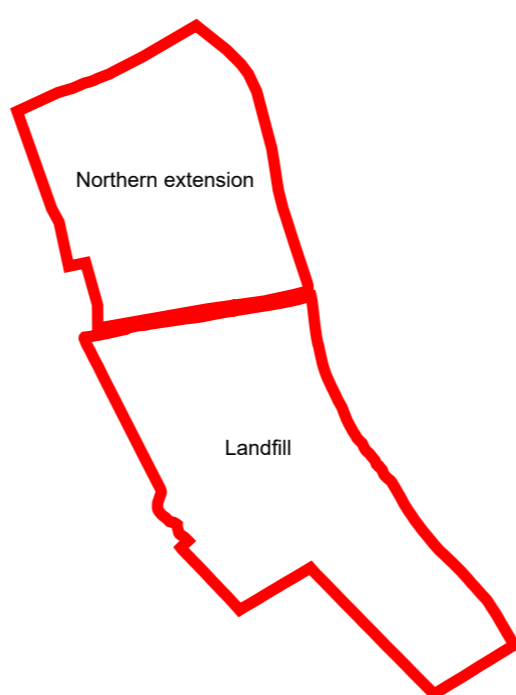

NOTES

Quarry faces will be restored through a combination of slopes created against them with scree and magnesian limestone grassland, retained faces and restoration blasting where required to soften the linear appearance.

Additional woodland and scattered tree and shrub planting will also be added to soften the linear appearance. Details shown are indicative at this stage and will be agreed through the detailed restoration design process and annual reviews.
