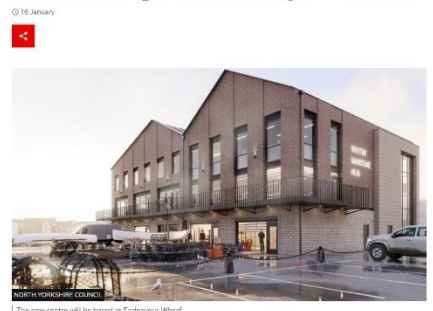

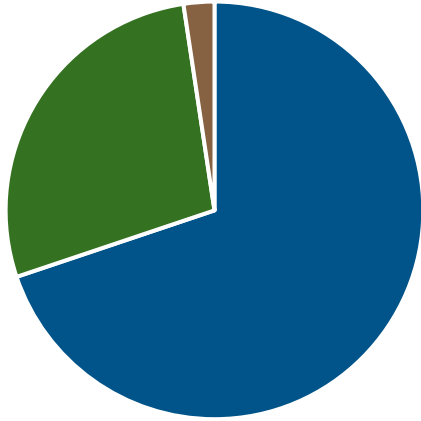

A £10 million investment will be made in Whitby to place it at the forefront of the expanding offshore renewable industries and boost job opportunities for the local community.

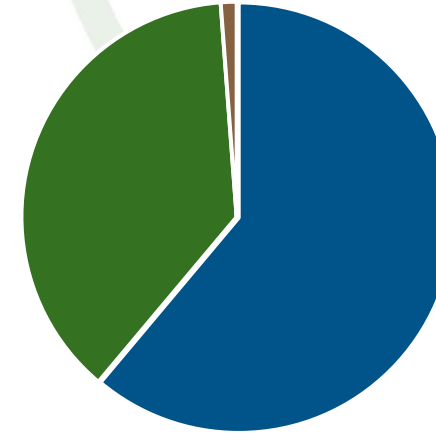

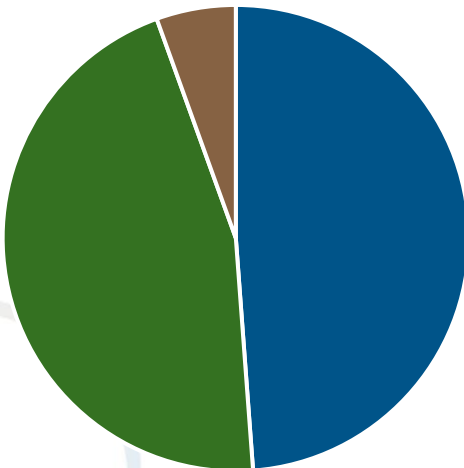

Quayside Location is the Best Site for the Hub



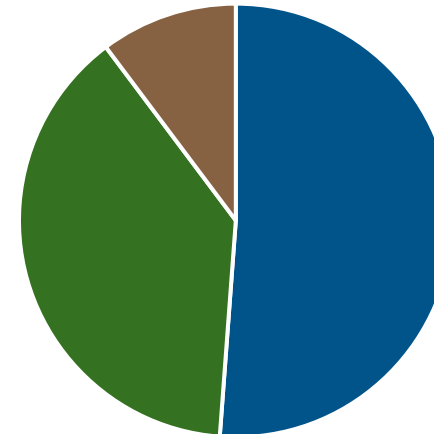

Design Reflects Scale of the Buildings in Whitby



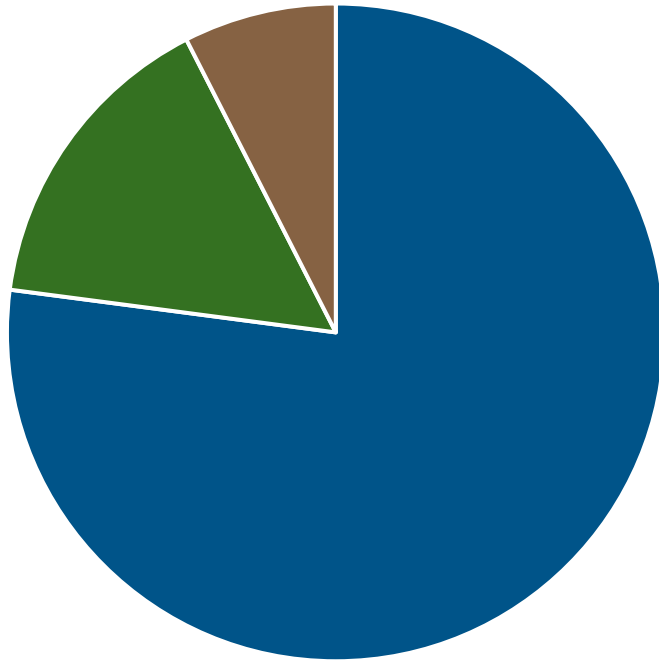

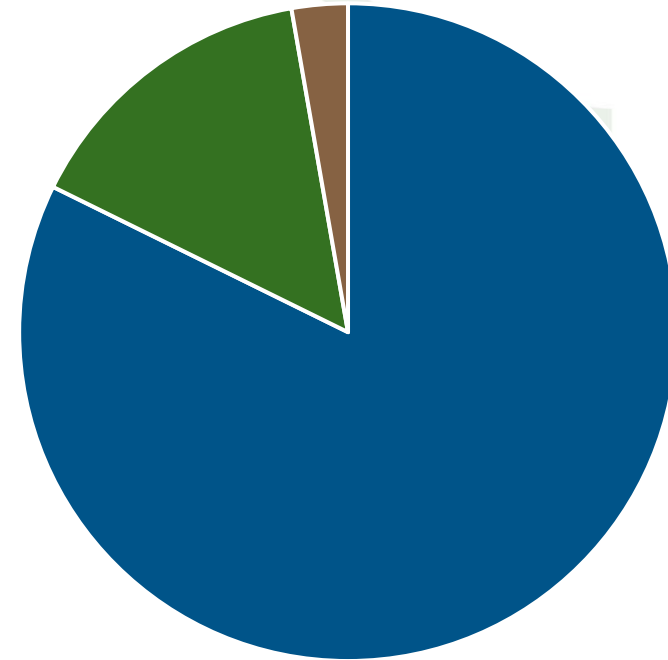

Creating a Sustainable Building, a Key Priority



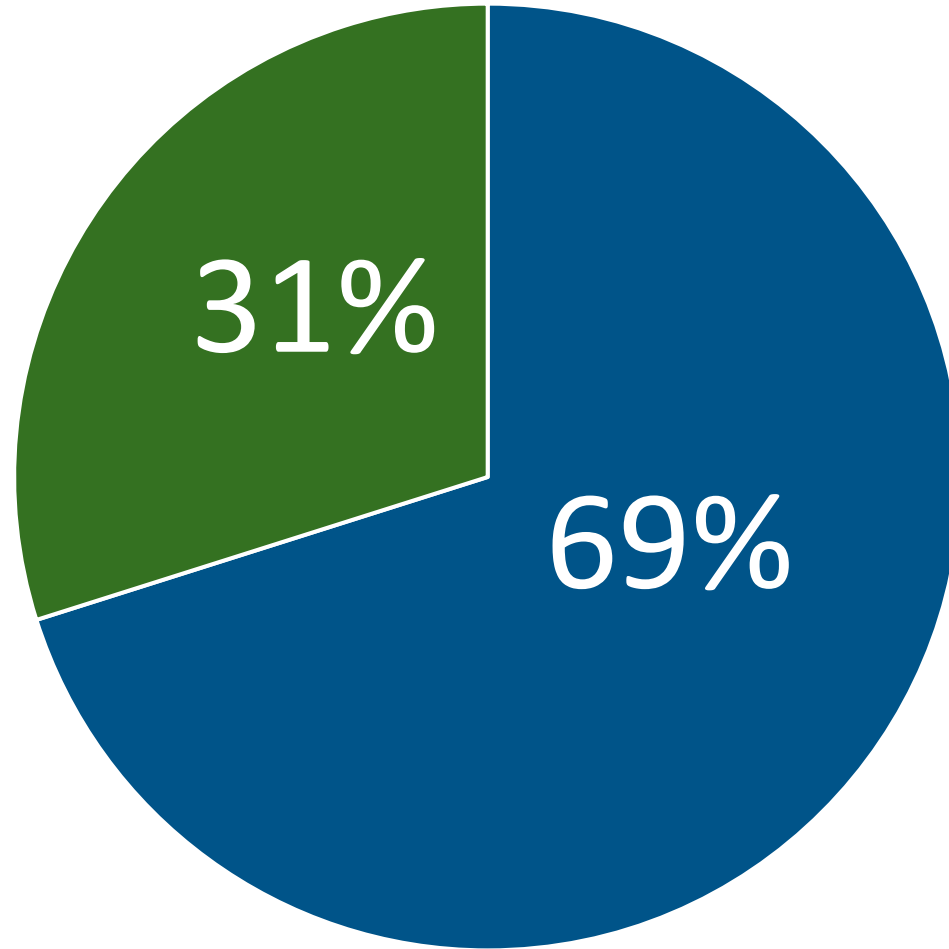
