

## THE TRUNK ROAD (VARIOUS ROADS, SELBY) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1987

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections $1(1)$ and (2), 2(1) and (2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Road (Various Roads, Selby) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1987, and shall come into force on $17^{\text {m }}$ March 1987.
2. (1) In this Order-
"the Act of 1984" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specifications for Parking Discs (BS No 4631: 1970), but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins;
"the trunk road" means the Liverpooi - Leeus - Huil Trunk noad (Áb3 and A19) or the East of Snaith - York - Thirsk - Stockton on Tees - Sunderland Trunk Road (AlO41 and Al9).
(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying -
(a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when -
(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or nearside of the vehicle, and
(b) a parking disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards, and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.
(3) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article in or Schedule to this Order which bears that number.

3. Nothing in article 3 shall apply so as to prevent a vehicle from waiting for so long as may be necessary for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
4. (1) Nothing in paragraph (a) or (b) of article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle, which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began), to wait in a length, or a length of a side, of road referred to therein for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length or a length of a side, of road on the same day).
(2) Nothing in paragraph (c) of article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle, which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, to wait in a length of a side of road referred to therein.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles, the provision of this Order shall prevail.
6. The Trunk Road (Various Roads, Selby) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1984(a), is hereby revoked.

Lengths and lengths of sides of the trunk road in the District of Selby in the County of North Yorkshire

MARKET PLACE (Al9)

NEW STREET (A19)

GOWTHORPE (A63)

GOWTHORPE (Al9).:

BAWTRY ROAD (A1041)
(a) North side, from its junction with Finkle Street to a point 73 metres east of that junction;
(b) South side, from its junction with New Lane to its junction with James Street.

Both sides, from a point 131 metres south-west of its junction with Ousegate to that junction.
(a) North side, from its junction with Scott Road to a point 85 metres south-west of that junction.
(b) South side, from its junction with Brook Street to a point 52 metres south-west of that junction.

Both sides, from its junction with Scott Road to a point 61 metres north-east of that junction.

Both sides, from its junction with Park Street to a point 260 metres south-east of that junction.

## SCHEDULE 2

(Waiting prohibited between the hours of 8.00 an and 6.00 pm on any day other than a Sunday)

Lengths and lengths of sides of the trunk road in the District of Selby in the County of North Yorkshire

GOWTHORPE (A63)

GOWTHORPE (A19)
(a) North side, from a point 85 metres south-west of its junction with Scott Road to a point 135 metres south-west of that junction;
(b) South side, from a point 52 metres south-west of its junction with Brook Street to a point 130 metres south-west of that junction.
(a) North side, from its junction with Finkle Street to a point 68 metres south-west of that junction;
(b) South side, from a point 61 metres east of its junction with Brook Street in an easterly direction to its junction with New Lane;
(c) North side, from a point 105 metres south-west of its junction with Finkle Street to a point 127 metres south-west of that junction.

THE CRESCENT (Al9)

PARK STREET (AlO41)

Both sides, from its junction with Market Place to its junction with New Street.
(a) East side, from its junction with The Crescent, to a point 34 metres south of that junction;
(b) West side, from its junction with The Crescent to a point 56 metres south of its junction with Abbey Yard.

## SCHEDULE 3

(Waiting for more than 30 minutes prohibited and no return within 90 minutes between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pa on any day other than a Sunday)

Lengths of Sides of the trunk road in the District of Selby
in the County of North Yorkshire

GOWTHORPE (A19)

PARK STREET (A1042)
(a) North side, from a point 61 metres north-east of its junction with Scott Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 96 metres;
(b) North side, from a point 68 metres south-west of its junction with Finkle Street to a point 105 metres south-west of that junction.

East side, from a point 34 metres soutin of its junction with The Crescent to a point 75 metres south of that junction.
