I appreciate that you already have CCTV covering the inside of the premises, however it would be proportionate for me to request that you update the cctv conditions attached to your licence and also request cctv to cover the external area where alcohol will be consumed.

I would therefore ask that you agree to the conditions below and confirm this in writing. As per our conversation, I am more than happy to come to the premises and speak with the person who is going to install the extra cameras.

Conditions agreed with North Yorkshire Police

- a. A digital colour CCTV system will be installed to cover the premises and recorded coverage will include all

- c. The recordings should be of good evidential quality to be produced in Court or other such hearing.
