Minutes: The Minutes of the last Meeting dated 9th October 2020 having been circulated to all Members were signed as a true record.

Matters Arising: VAS sign for North Grimston

Birdsall Telephone Kiosk

BT would remove the Kiosk if it was not adopted - Lord Middleton agreed Birdsall Estates Co. Ltd. would take it over but due to too many regulations it has been decided BT should remove it.

Roads

N.Y.C.C. Highways Officer replied on the 23rd October 2020 in reply to the Clerk's letter of 12th October 2020:-

- (1) The damaged roadside chevrons on the bend near North Grimston House have been replaced.
- (2) The sign at the 'T' junction where the road from Sevington joins the B1248 has been replaced.
- (3) The lorry punctures on North Grimston Hill appear to be unfortunate occurrences.

Vacancy for Parish Councillor

Pay ments:

Clerk's Fee:- The Clerk's Fee of £100 and Postages of £39-30 were approved for payment.

Roads:

The Clerk was asked to report the bad state of the following roads to N.Y.C.C. Highways Department :-

Toftland : Mill Road, Birdseye : From Pitts Wood to Burythorpe corner, Birdseye and the road from North Brinsford to Langton from Blebe Farm to the Birdseye 'T' junction.
