Matters Roads etc.

Arising: Lady Middleton read out a letter from North Yorkshire County Council dated 6th December 2018 in reply to her letter of 17th October 2018 regarding various matters as follows:

Gullies near Anthony Cottages, Birdsall.

These comments were noted and it was agreed to write again regarding Mill Lane, Birdsall.

Parish Precept: It was confirmed that the Clerk had submitted a Precept of £140 for the year 2019/2020 - the same amount as the previous year.

Yorkshire Local Councils Association: A letter from YLCA dated 24th January 2019 (having been circulated to all members) inviting the Parish Council to join for a trial period of 3 months for a pro rata sum of £30 was discussed and agreed not to take up this offer.

Nomination Papers: Nomination Papers for the Parish Council Elections on the 2nd May 2019 were handed out and subsequently completed for submission to Ryedale District Council.

Mr. Ben Stone: Mr. Ben Stone submitted his resignation due to pressure of other work.

Thomas Parson Trust: It was agreed that Mr. Simon McMillan would look into the possibility of getting a Defibrillator for Birdsall this year and for North Grimston next year.
