NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along any length of road specified in column 2 of the Schedule below, in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in column 3 of that Schedule.
