## Selby & Ainsty ACC Budget Shortlisting

# A. Interactive Towns

Commission interactive town map/guides for Selby and Tadcaster.\*  
Produce in various formats e.g. map boards, poster, leaflet, PDF etc.

Could include:

- Car parks
- Walking trails
- History trails
- Arts and culture
- Shopping
- Green spaces
- Public amenities
- Defibrillator locations
- Market day(s)

COST:

£2,000 per town for design work  
£8,000 per town for signage production and installation

Suggested budget allocation £20,000

\*£10k contribution already in place for Sherburn-In-Elmet from Shared Prosperity Fund



## B. Real Time Bus Information

Commission digital Real Time Bus Information units for bus stops in Selby, Tadcaster and Sherburn-In-Elmet.

Vix Technology will install get set up the display. The data is managed by West Yorkshire Combined Authority.

£10k per unit (installed)  
inc maintenance for 10 years

Funding already approved for:  
2 units for Sherburn  
1 unit for Tadcaster

COST: £60k would fund...  
2 additional units for Tadcaster  
4 units for Selby



## C. Town Centre WiFi

Commission extension to town centre WiFi in Selby and Sherburn to cover Selby Park, Selby bus station and Selby railway station plus Sherburn Station.

NYnet provides free public wi-fi in 20 towns in order to support growth for communities and businesses. It helps to promote local shops and services, and also offers opportunities for people with limited or no broadband to access vital local services and take part in the digital economy.

Selby has higher than average usage of the existing service but is only partially covered. Sherburn Station is not currently covered Tadcaster town centre is fully covered already.

COST:  
£40k (approx)

## D. Village Cinemas

Provision of cinema facilities for two village communities in the Selby & Ainsty area, similar to the current facilities in Sherburn-in-Elmet and Tadcaster.

Villages/host organisations to be confirmed, but must be able to provide a suitable venue and a robust plan for delivery of a regular cinema programme

Suggested facilities:

- Projector
- Screen
- Blackout blinds

COST: £20k  
£10k per venue
