The Premises Licence Holder or Designated Premises Supervisor are advised to carry out a simple "sound check" outside the nearest noise sensitive property when regulated entertainment is taking place, by listening to the music etc. coming from regulated entertainment. If the music etc. is clearly audible, then it is likely that this condition is being breached. Steps should then be taken to reduce the volume of the noise.
