Good afternoon,

I am writing to you regarding the above application. You have submitted a representation and can advise the applicant has offered further assurances to the concerns raised in your representation (please see the 3rd attachment), this is in addition to the agreed conditions with North Yorkshire Police (attached) and the conditions offered by the applicant on the application (attached).

Please be advised that under the Licensing Act 2003 at any stage, following the grant of a premises licence or club premises certificate, a responsible authority, or any other person, may ask the licensing authority to review the licence because of a matter arising at the premises in connection with any of the four licensing objectives

If a review application is accepted a hearing would be convened, the options available to the Licensing Sub-Committee would be:

- modify the conditions of the premises licence (which includes adding new conditions or any alteration or omission of an existing condition), for example, by reducing the hours of opening or by requiring door supervisors at particular times;
- exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence, for example, to exclude the performance of live music or playing of recorded music (where it is not within the incidental live and recorded music exemption);
- remove the designated premises supervisor, for example, because they consider that the problems are the result of poor management;
- suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months;
- revoke the licence

If the above information provided (including the attached documents) allays your concerns you can withdraw your representation by responding to this email. Should you not wish to withdraw your representation a licensing sub-committee hearing will be held to determine the outcome of the application submitted to the Licensing Authority; you will receive an invitation to the hearing which will allow you to put forward your representation to the committee (or the relevant part of your representation) and a link to the report will also be sent to you.
