








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# Scheme Scope

- o 27.8-hectare site
- o 4km new highway,
- 12 new structures walls / underpass / culverts.
- Take down 3.3km dry stone walling, build 4.3km
- Vegetation clearance 64,000 m2
- Timber / wire fence 6.4km
- Vehicle Restraint System 3.2km
- Drainage pipes 9km
- Utility duct 12km Zayo/BT/NPG /YW diversions
- Excavation 370,000m3
- $\circ$  Bird / bat / Owl boxes 60
- $\circ$  New shrubs / trees 12,000 no.

- Cut and fill earthworks to form highway base.
- Excavating for drainage outfall pond

#### Works activity: earthworks benching





- Highway formation earthworks
- Benching for new embankments, up to 8m high.

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- Benching for new embankments up to 8m high.

### Works activity: land slip Feb – June 24

- 14<sup>th</sup> land slide in 2 decades.
- This case subbase wash out / embankment collapse
- 2 sections 60m & 24m in length / width 500mm / depth 1m
- Highway reopened 21<sup>st</sup> June


