Altair is the system used by NYPF to administrate, amend and properly meet the needs of all members of the pension fund within the geographical areas of North Yorkshire and the City of York. The current provider is Aquilla Heywood who the Authority have been in contract with since 2015. The decision is to re-procure a compliant system for the next iteration of this contract.
