
North Yorkshire County Council is so sharing a COVID-19 ....

If your business employs people who cannot work from home then make sure you register for your free #coronavirus tests by 31 March. All businesses in England are eligible to register to order rapid lateral flow devices to test staff at work twice a week. The tests give results within 30 minutes to help reduce the spread of infection.
