I note that Kitson & Sons Ltd have applied for the following activities between 23:00 - 02:00 Monday- Saturday and between 23:00 and 00:00 on Sundays: Live Music, Recorded Music, Late Night Refreshments, and for the Sale of alcohol 08:00 - 02:00 Monday - Saturday and between 08:00 - 00:00 on Sundays.

I object to the late night music and the sale of alcohol at such times since this will a) no doubt attract large crowds and as a result b) a significant increase in the volume of traffic in the village that will cause c) significant changes the atmosphere of the village and d) even great parking problems than we already have.

I can also see no reason why the premises should be open for the sale of alcohol at 08:00. If people want alcohol at the time of day, SPAR is available.

If this license is granted the cumulative effects are wholly undesirable in a village of this size. Road access and parking is limited and late night arrival and departures will disturb the peace and tranquility of the area.
