

Procurement exercise to establish a framework arrangement for pitched and flat roofing works

PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION

To undertake a procurement exercise to establish a framework arrangement for pitched and flat roofing works

BACKGROUND TO SUPPORT THE RECOMMENDATION

The Council's previous themed roofing framework expired in 2019. A decision has been made to undertake a procurement exercise to establish new framework arrangements for pitched and flat roofing works. The procurement will commence later this year with a view to having a new framework in place by April 2021. There will be two lots. Lot 1: Hambleton, Scarborough, Selby and Ryedale district areas and Lot 2: Richmondshire, Harrogate and Craven district areas. It is proposed that the framework will be for a duration of two years with options to extend for a further two, one year, periods. Maximum framework period 4 years.

LEGAL AND GOVERNANCE COMPLIANCE

The procurement exercise will be undertaken by the Council's Procurement and Contract Management Service via an open tender process.

This is a key decision. The proposal to procure was entered on the forward plan in August 2020.

RECOMMENDATION

That the procurement exercise to establish new framework arrangements for pitched and flat roofing works be approved.
