Dear Licensing Department,

We would like to appeal the timings for the licence application for BOSC KITCHEN, DL8 3QL.

We are delighted that the premises will be serving food, but as we're in pretty much a residential area – as previous licence applications have mentioned and been declined serving past 7pm.

We live on the opposite side of the road 10m away, our guest rooms directly overlooking their premises, these are particularly susceptible to rising noise levels, we have a real issue with the lateness currently applied for especially with some outside tables.

All noise carries so much in this area during the evenings when the traffic dies down after about 6pm. We are often disturbed by noise from the customers outside the Hawes club and The White Hart Pub either side of us within 60m often until late evening.

We do not want an even closer premises being given a licence to serve customers alcohol after 9pm absolute latest. The reasoning behind this is that most of our guests up to a maximum of 12 people, are in bed by 9pm because they have been walking all day and are tired and deserve undisturbed rest as we do ourselves.

To finish, we would also like to point out that last year, the applicants have already been very inconsiderate with noise at unreasonable hours - 6am having skips delivered right beside our building on 2 separate occasions; with low traffic noise at this time it woke us and our guests all up, without any warnings.

When I complained to them about this, I received a very abusive response from [REDACTED]
