Ensure the reasons for any delays are discussed at your pensions committee and local pension board meetings. 2. Ensure you have a project plan in place to complete the remedy work. This should document the key stages and note the reasons for any delay, the expected impact and what you are doing to mitigate further delays. 3. Make sure you include information about any pension software issues and the impact of this in your risk register. 4. Consider whether you will use the discretion provided by the LGPS (Information) Regulations 2024 (or, for authorities in Scotland, the LGPS (Remediable Service) (Miscellaneous Amendment) Regulations 2024) to not include underpin information in the 2025 ABSs.</p> <p>Sharing data for McCloud with other schemes Review your processes to make sure that you do not require a member's written consent before you respond this type of request.
