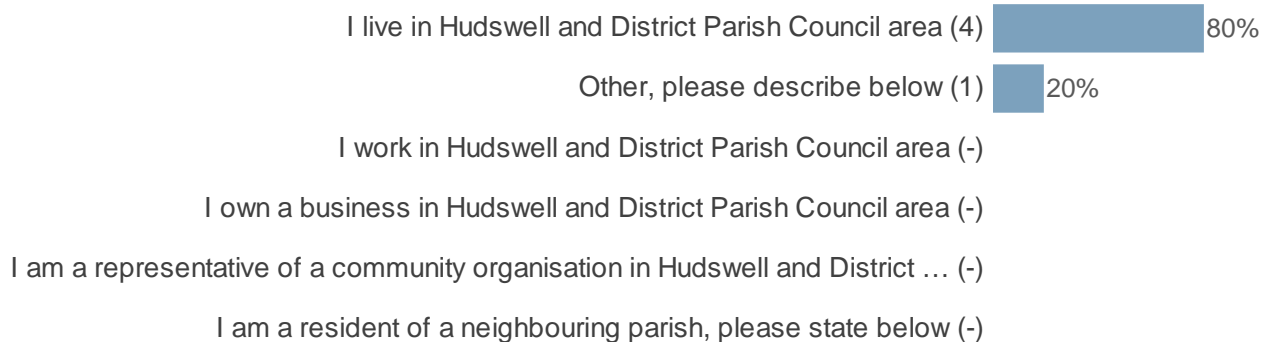


2025-26 CGR - Hudswell
